ORDER

Sub:- Use of Banners/ flags during the Election campaign.

Whereas the State Election Commission is of the view that the number of banners and flags used for campaigning purposes by the candidates / political parties either on the propaganda vehicle or at the venues of the political meetings needs to be regulated;

Therefore, the State Election Commission in exercise of powers vested in it under Article 243K of Constitution of India read with Section 237 of Goa Panchayat Raj Act,1994 issues the following directions to all concerned for necessary compliance:

As far as the number of banners/posters/flags is concerned, it is limited to one banner per vehicle on the authorized vehicles; one banner at the office premises and one banner at the venue of the public meeting.

Secondly, as far as the flags are concerned, one flag on each authorized vehicle ;one flag at the office and one flag at venue of the meeting is allowed.

After the meeting is over, the banner and the flag should be removed from the venue of the meeting by the candidate concerned.
