Sub.:- Maximum Limit of Expenditure to be incurred by Contesting Candidates.

Read:-1/199/Standing orders/2020-SEC/1233 Dated:30/10/2020.

And Whereas, under Article 243ZA of the Constitution of India, read with Section 11(1) of the City of Panaji Corporation Act, 2002, the State Election Commission is vested with the powers of Superintendence, direction and control for the conduct of the elections to the Corporation.

Whereas it is necessary and expedient to provide in the interest of purity of election to Corporation of the City of Panaji wards an account of expenditure incurred by the candidate and for matters connected therein.

Now, therefore, this Commission hereby directs as follows:-

1. Monitoring of election expenditures incurred by the candidates shall be as per above referred Order.
2. The maximum limit of total election expenses by a Contesting Candidate in a Ward of Corporation of the City of Panaji has been fixed at Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rs. Two Lakh Fifty thousand only).

NOTIFICATION

Whereas the General Election to 30 Wards of Corporation of the City of Panaji will be conducted on 20th March, 2021 and the polling for the above Corporation will be from 8.00 hrs. to 17.00 hrs.

And whereas Rule 34(1) of the Corporation of the City of Panaji (Election) Rules, 2004 provides for an indelible ink mark to be put on the left forefinger of every voter before issue of ballot paper at the Polling Station. This is aimed to prevent impersonation of Voters at Polling Station.

And whereas the Zilla Panchayat of North and South Goa Constituencies in the State of Goa was held on 12th December, 2020 and similar indelible ink mark has been put on the left forefinger of every voter. Hence there is a possibility that this mark may still be partially visible on the left forefinger of some of the voters.

Now, therefore, in order to avoid confusion and to prevent impersonation by voters without causing hardships to genuine voters and in exercise of the powers vested under Article 243ZA of the Constitution of India and also under Section 11 of the The City of Panaji Corporation Act, 2002 read with Rule 3 of the Corporation of City of Panaji (Election) Rules, 2004, it is hereby directed that the indelible ink mark shall be put on **Left middle finger** of every voter at the polling Station before issue of ballot paper instead of Left forefinger. If the voter has no Left middle finger then the ink should be applied on Left Ring finger.

Subject:- Restriction on number of vehicles and people at the time of nominations for CCP Election 2021.

While filing of nominations in the office of Returning Officer proper control and order needs to be maintained to avoid overcrowding by the supporters of the candidates so that problem of overcrowding of the office of Returning Officer at the time of filing nomination does not arise. The following directions therefore are to be followed.

The DEO/RO/ARO may inform the contestants and interest groups that the maximum number of vehicles that will be allowed to come within the periphery of 100 mtrs. of Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer's office shall be **two** and maximum number of persons that will be allowed to enter the office of Returning Officer/Assistant Returning Officer at the time of filing the nomination shall be candidate and his proposer proposing the nomination of the candidate and one more person i.e. there can be **only three person** (including the candidate) who can remain present inside the Returning Officer's room at the time of filing nomination.
